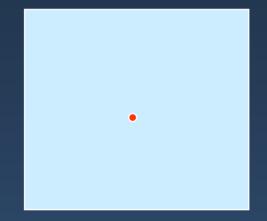

Functionality

The problem to study

- A radioactive source inside a box of water
- We want to study the energy deposit in the water



What do we need?

Modeling

- The experimental set up
 - Geometry
 - Materials
- The primary event
 - The decay spectrum of the radioactive source
- The physics interactions of particles with matter
 - The physics processes
 - Their cross-sections
 - The secondary particles generated
 - ...

Dealing with the details of the simulation

- Handling the tracking of particles through matter
 - stepping
- Handling the transportation of particles
 - Navigation through volumes
- A mechanism to collect the physically interesting information
 - and register it for future analysis
- Handling the chunks of the simulation
 - Runs, events, tracks, steps...

Looking at what happens

Visualisation

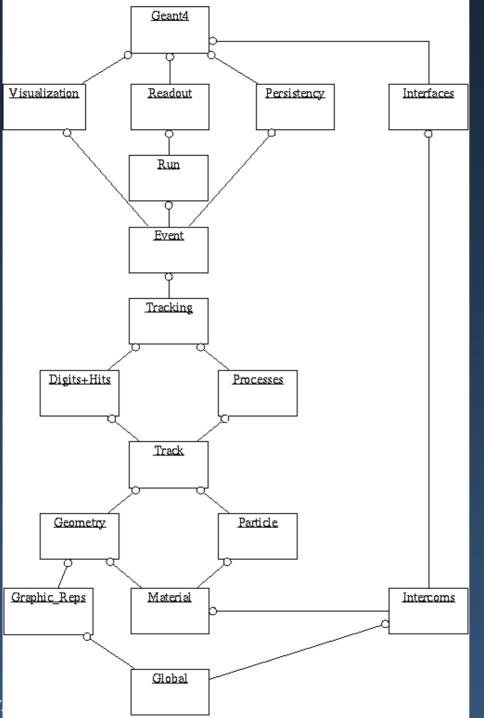
- Experimental set-up
- Tracks produced, energy deposit
- Etc.

Analysis of the results

- Histograms of the relevant physical quantities
- Collection of significant info for each event (track)
- Etc.
- Saving the events generated for future re-elaboration
 - persistency

The toolkit

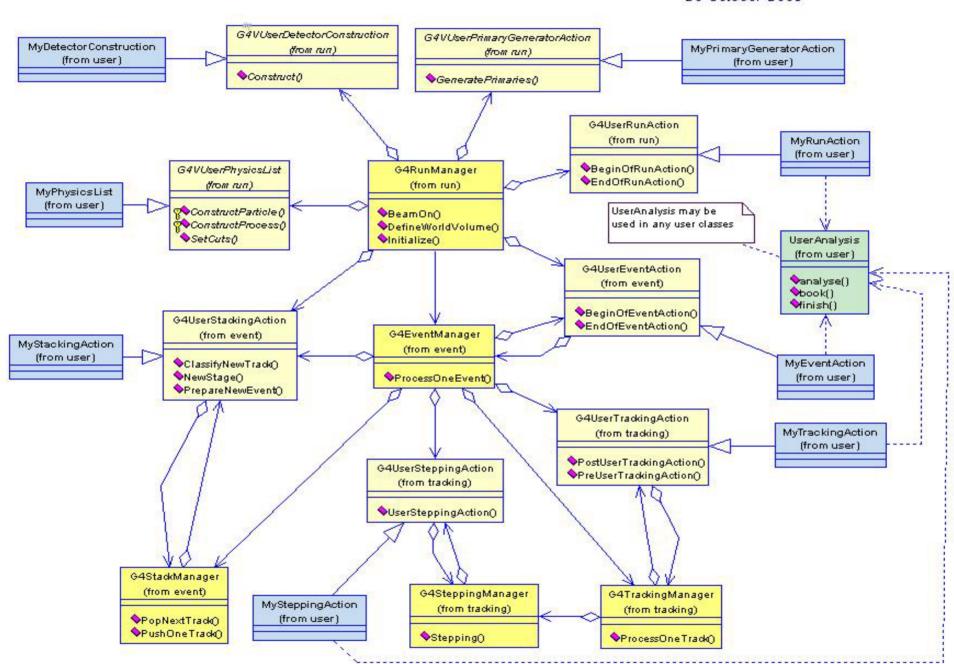
- Putting all things together
- Making them work together
- Interacting with external systems
