• Transversely polarised target, unpolarised beam: T

Quasi 2-body approach

reaction $\gamma p \rightarrow p \pi^0 \pi^0$ use quasi 2-body approach \Rightarrow single meson photoproduction

two choices for two particle system • $p(\pi^0\pi^0)$ • $(p\pi^0)\pi^0$



single meson: $\mathcal{O}(E_{\gamma}, \cos \vartheta)$ double meson: $\mathcal{O}(E_{\gamma}, \cos \vartheta, m_{12}, \phi^*, \theta^*)$

- Our experimental knowledge of the spectrum and properties of baryon resonances is steadily increasing!
 ↔ Important contribution from photoproduction experiments
 - CBELSA/TAPS:
 - New high quality double polarisation data
 - Various final states
 - Existing PWA predictions: Large discrepancies in comparison to new data
 - $\bullet \rightarrow {\rm New \ data \ provides \ important \ constraints} \\ {\rm for \ extraction \ of \ baryon \ resonances} }$
- New experimental information = detailed testing ground for quark models, lattice QCD, dynamically generated resonances, ... other theoretical approaches
- $\bullet \Rightarrow {\sf Significant\ contribution\ to\ a\ better\ understanding} \\ {\sf of\ QCD\ in\ the\ non-pertubative\ regime}$



Dilution factor

- Protons in H_2 -Molecules are not polarisable
- $\bullet\,$ Butanol as target material contains C and O
- Dilution factor $f = \frac{10}{10+32} = 0.24$
- Eff. dilution factor $f = \frac{N_{\rm H}}{N_{\rm Butanol}} = \frac{N_{\rm Butanol} N_{\rm C}}{N_{\rm Butanol}}$ larger, because of
 - Fermi momentum
